The author protection used for documents of RI-UTM is from Creative Commons (CC). It allows to disseminate the work with its respective authorship so that other people get to know it or even use it and cite it without modifying it or making a profit from it. Creative Commons defines it as Noncommercial Attribution and NO derivatives and is represented by the acronym

CC BY-NC-ND

or with the following image.



It is about a restrictive license that allows other people to download it or even share the works they refer as long as they acknowledge the authorship. It means, to acknowledge the work who published it the first time. But it does not allow other people to use it in a commercial way nor do they allow to change it or make derivatives from it. This type of license is the most restrictive among CC.
